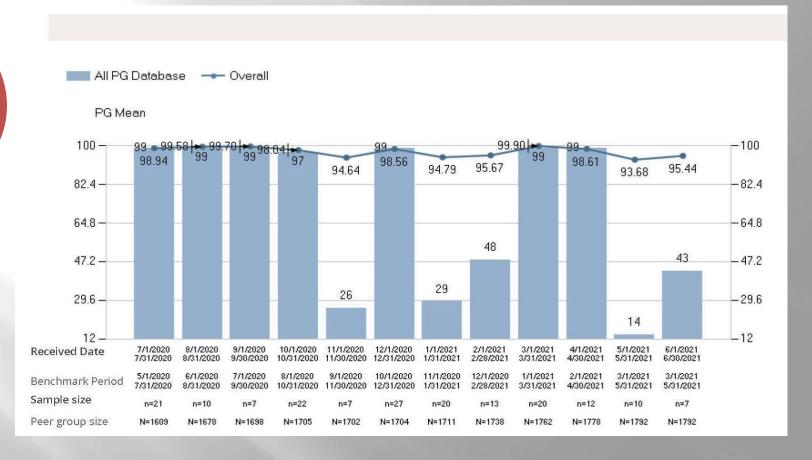
Patient Satisfaction Overall Score Inpatient Services

- Nursing Staff will be involved in monitoring the patient on a regular basis;
- The inpatient stay shall last approximately three (3) days, depending upon the drug(s) used by the patient, as well as their physical condition;
- An appropriate discharge referral is developed prior to the patient leaving the hospital which can include outpatient and long or short term rehabilitation and follow-up counseling.

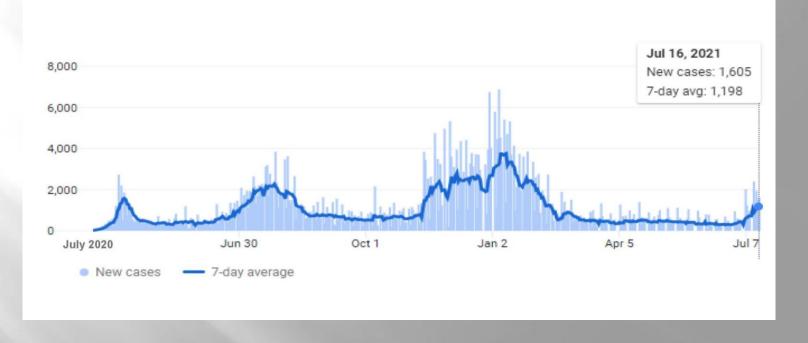

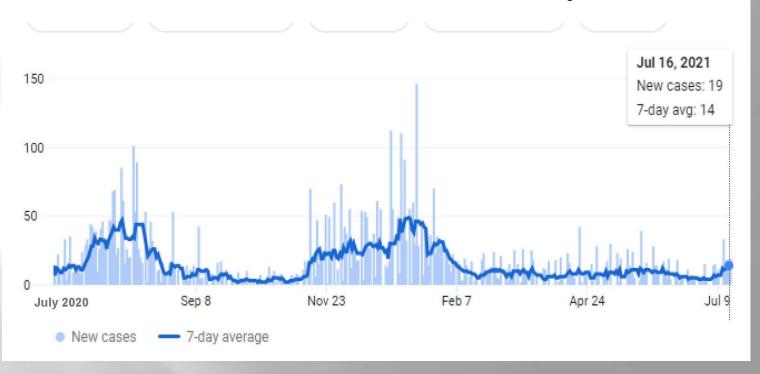


Coronavirus (Covid-19) Data State, Parish. Abbeville General

Louisiana COVID Positivity Rate



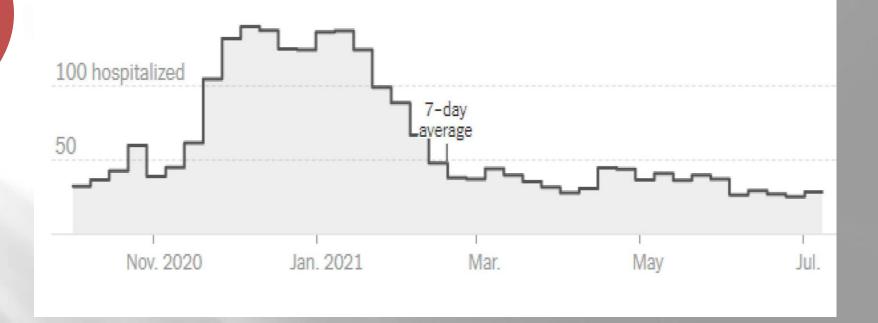




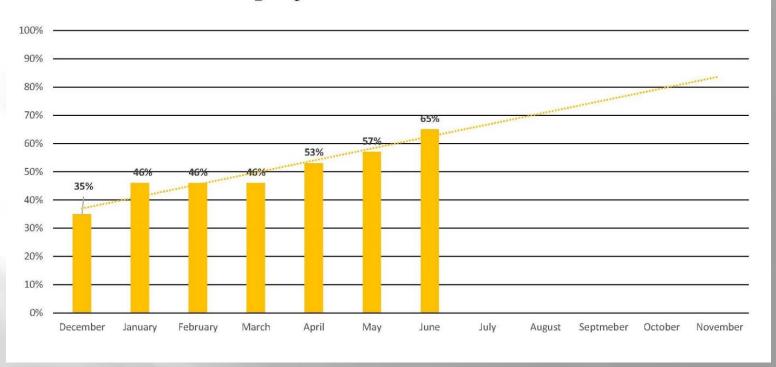
Abbeville General Hospital Positivity Rate

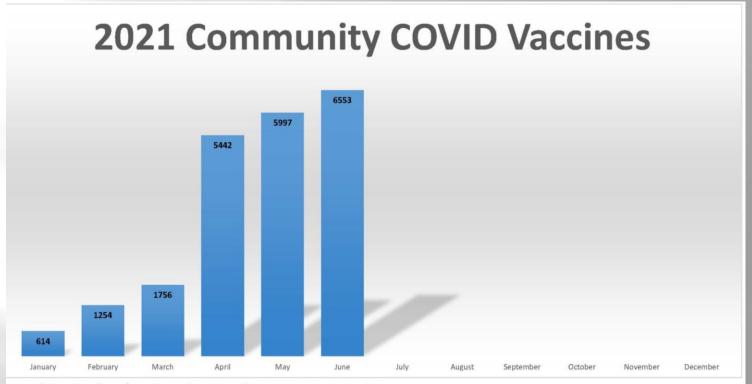


Hospitalized Covid-19 patients in the Vermilion Parish area
